

Tops made from lightweight cores and table components, including tops, legs, modesty panels and fixtures boxes, store in the industry's most compact upright carts, allowing a room full of tables to easily fit in a storage closet. Tilting and folding T-base leg styles are also available.

SUMMIT

WallGoldfinger Furniture's patent pending Summit tilt-top tables offer the ultimate in reconfigurability for conference rooms and more. Tabletops tilt to allow them to fit through doorways, and tables are set on casters so they can easily roll to create a new table configuration or to be stored. When the tabletop is lowered, the casters automatically retract for stability.

Most commonly made in a 60- by 60-inch size, tables nest for compact storage. Eight 60- by 60-inch Summits store in just 65 square feet, or a 5-foot by 13-foot space. And both the Arbor and Summit are offered in incredibly diverse materials to complement any room design.


FACTORY

The factory itself is powered by onsite wind and solar. And the factory is warmed with heat created from burning waste woods that would otherwise end up in a landfill.

The finishing department is the only in the nation with an automated system of its type, offering the ultimate in quality, consistency and environmental control.


Top image: a look inside part of the Mark Richey factory; bottom images from left: woodworking, CNC, finish, reassembly

Mark Richey Woodworking is among the nation's greenest manufacturers and a 2017 winner of the National Pollution Prevention Roundtable Award. In addition to the use of wind, solar and biomass, the Mark Richey team gives back to its local and world community through power generation, and relief efforts and building projects in Haiti, Afghanistan and Nepal.
